Please advise the Council Service Center at (512) 926-6363 or (800) 444-1910 and the Lost Pines Camp Ranger at (512) 303-7401 or the Wolf Mountain Ranch Manager at (915) 247-5222, if you are unable to conduct a scheduled activity.

## Roster

Please provide the Camp Ranger or Ranch Manager with a roster of youth and adult members upon arrival in camp (see reverse). If you are using Green Dickson Camp, please mail the roster to the Council Service Center. No pets allowed in camp.

## Agreement (sign in adjacent column)

We understand that this application is not a reservation until we have received confirmation back that space is available as per our request. We also understand that the grounds, buildings, and equipment will be left in good condition and that general Scout camping rules will be observed. We understand that the leader responsible for the group must be a registered Scouter at least twenty-one (21) years of age.

All vehicles must be parked in designated parking area. The Camp Ranger can permit one vehicle to go into your campsite to the unloaded; however, this vehicle must be returned to a designated parking area.
