We understand that this application is not a reservation until we have received confirmation back that space is available as per our request. We also understand that the grounds, buildings, and equipment will be left in good condition and that general Scout camping rules will be observed. We understand that the leader responsible for the group must be a registered Scouter at least twenty-one (21) years of age.

All vehicles must be parked in designated parking area. The Camp Ranger can permit one vehicle to go into your campsite to the unloaded; however, this vehicle must be returned to a designated parking area.

We understand that a fee of ten dollars (\$10) per session will be paid at the Council Service Center at the time we make our camping reservations before we can use the tower and equipment. We further understand that any equipment found to be missing upon check-in of said equipment will be billed to our unit. We understand further that our Wood Mountain certified leader(s) must be on the tower during our use of the tower and is/are the person(s) qualified to belay climbers and/or rappellers during said use.
